Why SeniorPak?

SeniorPak is designed to ADDRESS HUNGER among our senior citizens. Often seniors will sacrifice on food to pay high utilities or medical bills. Receiving supplemental food allows seniors more of their income to manage other expenses.

Do Senior Citizens Pay for it?

NO!

This service is offered free of charge to eligible senior citizens through sponsorships of \$125.00 per year. ANYONE other than the recipient can be a sponsor! You may also designate your sponsorship to an eligible senior of your choice.

Where does the food come from?

All food is obtained through the Community Harvest Food Bank. Food producers, manufacturers, distributors, area wholesalers, and individuals donate to the Community Harvest Food Bank.

What are the eligibility guidelines?

Low income seniors 60 and over

Note: Seniors with a moderate income that is reduced by unusually high medical expenses can also be considered by the program. Call for information at 925-3311.

How can I help?

You can help by ENCOURAGING your group or organization to sponsor one or more seniors.

You can help by VOLUNTEERING to help with the SeniorPak program. We have many volunteers who solicit donations, keep records, pick up the sacks in Fort Wayne, organize the sacks for distribution, and others who deliver the sacks. Could you help?
